Highlights: Training in case study analysis Development of effective oral presentation and seminar intercultural communication skills Development of critical reading and writing skills required for MBA programs Exposure to economics, management, and finance vocabulary and concepts Workshops and lectures by entrepreneurs and MBA faculty Important Notes: The Pre-MBA program is a Level 6 (High Advanced) program. Students must take a placement exam when they arrive at the ELI to determine their English level. Only students in Level 6 (our highest level) can enroll in this program. The Pre-MBA program is comprised of four courses at Level 6: two reading/writing courses and two listening/speaking classes. Only one R/W and one L/S course may be taken per session. As a result, the Pre-MBA takes two ELI sessions (approximately four months) to complete. The Pre-MBA program is also considered the "required curriculum" for students in the Graduate Conditional Admissions Program (Graduate CAP) who plan to pursue their MBA.
