William Ritter joined the University of Delaware faculty in 1971 and retired December, 2014. He was professor of bioresources and environmental and civil engineering. He continues to serve as a senior policy fellow in the Center Energy and Environmental Policy. At the University of Delaware he has had appointments in teaching, research and extension and served as department chair of the Bioresources Engineering Department for 15 years. He has conducted research on groundwater quality, nonpoint source pollution, irrigation water management, water quality modeling, livestock waste management, land application of wastes and wastewater treatment. He has served as a consultant to state and federal government agencies, engineering consulting firms, industry and non-profit organizations. He has taught courses in wastewater treatment, water treatment, irrigation and drainage engineering, hydrology, water resources management, soil and water conservation, soil physics, solid waste management and agricultural air pollution. He has over 300 refereed journal papers, conference proceedings, book chapters, books, extension publication and technical reports and has presented over 200 papers at international, national and regional meetings.

He is a fellow of American Society of Civil Engineers and American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers and life member of both the Water Environment Federation and American Water Works Association. He is a diplomat of the American Academy of Water Resources Engineers and the American Academy of Environmental Engineers and Scientists. He has been editor of the Journal of Irrigation and Drainage Engineering since 2001 and has held leadership positions in both ASCE and ASABE. He has received numerous awards including the ASCE Royce Tipton Award, ASCE Richard R. Torrence Outstanding Editor Award, ASCE Delaware Section Civil Engineer of the Year, ASABE Gunloginson Countryside Engineering Award, ASABE-NAR Young Engineer of the Year and ASABE-NABEC Distinguished Service Award.
