Background: An award given in memory of Paris Delligatti, a 1997 graduate of the ATEP and Health and Physical Education program at UD. The award has been established thanks to the generous endowment of his parents Charles and Kathleen Delligatti.

Purpose: The scholarship will be awarded to a *sophomore or junior* student who shows a sincere desire to enter the profession of athletic training and demonstrates the qualities of character, friendship, perseverance, and concern for the welfare of athletes and fellow athletic training students as exemplified by Paris Delligatti.

Criteria:

- 1) ATEP GPA
- 2) Cumulative GPA
- 3) Total clinical experience hours
- 4) Extracurricular activities and community service related to athletic training
- 5) Involvement in SATC
- 6) Traits listed above in the purpose statement
- 7) Must demonstrate Financial Aid need as corroborated via UD's Office of Student Financial Aid --- only students who are eligible for aid will be considered!

Selection Committee: The ATEP Steering Committee

Award: The recipient will receive a financial award distribution to their student account, recognition certificate, and will have their name engraved on the perpetual wall plaque that hangs in the UD athletic training facility located in the Bob Carpenter Center. The student will also be formally recognized during the annual CHS Honor's Reception.
