INFORMATION FOR GRADUATES

Graduation Check-list

Please review the "prepare for graduation" check-list.

Convocation Programs

You must arrive in the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center corridor areas to assemble **no later than 11:30 a.m. if attending the first program and no later than 2:30 p.m. if attending the second program.** The University Commencement ceremony immediately precedes our first College program. Procession of the graduates will start at approximately 12:25 p.m. so we can begin our first Convocation program at 12:30 p.m. or as close to that time as possible. For graduates attending the 3:30 p.m. ceremony, procession of the graduates will begin at approximately 3:25 p.m.

- Convocation is a dignified occasion and academic regalia are **required**. Please conduct yourself in a manner that is respectful of your fellow graduates and their guests. Plan to attend the entire Convocation program. Each program will last approximately one hour and thirty minutes.
- No pets allowed with the exception of service animals.
- Concessions will be available for purchase both outside of the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center during the first program and on the second level of the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center for both programs; however, no food or drink is permitted on the arena floor.
- Line-up will be in the following corridors of the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center:

12:30 p.m. program:

- Entrepreneurship and Technology Innovation, Hospitality Industry Management, Hotel, Restaurant and Institutional Management, International Business Studies, Operations Management and Sport Management majors will line up in the corridor to the left as you enter the front lobby of the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center.
- Management and Marketing majors will line up in the corridor to the right of the trophy cases as you enter the front lobby of the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center.
- Double majors may choose either major for line-up.

3:30 p.m. program:

- Accounting and Economics majors will line up in the corridor to the left as you enter the front lobby of the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center.
- Finance, Financial Planning and Management Information Systems majors will line up in the corridor to the right of the trophy cases as you enter the front lobby of the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center.
- Double majors may choose either major for line-up.
- While waiting in the corridors, form a single line, keeping in mind that you will be seated with those in front of and behind you.
- Faculty marshals will seat graduates one row at a time.
- Once seated, complete the index card on your seat including a permanent mailing address and the Career Services Center Placement Survey. If your name is often mispronounced, please write it phonetically on the card. These will be collected as you approach the stage to be recognized.

- Marshals will lead graduates to and from the stage.
- An official photographer from GradImages will be taking your picture both on and off stage. You will be contacted directly by GradImages with ordering information approximately 48 hours following the ceremony. For additional information, please visit <u>www.gradimages.com</u>.
- After you are recognized, please return to your seat until the conclusion of the program.
- If you attend the first Convocation program, please arrange to meet your family and friends outside of the building immediately following the conclusion of the program. Our second Convocation program immediately follows and we would very much appreciate your cooperation in leaving the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center promptly.

Guests are encouraged to arrive at the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center **no later than 12:15 p.m. for the first program and 3:15 p.m. for the second program.** Procession of the graduates will start at approximately 12:25 p.m. so we can begin our first Convocation program at 12:30 p.m. or as close to that time as possible. If you will be attending the first Convocation program, please make every effort to be at the Bob Carpenter Sports/Convocation Center immediately following the Commencement ceremony. For graduates and families of graduates attending the 3:30 p.m. ceremony, procession of the graduates will begin at approximately 3:25 p.m.

- Convocation is a dignified occasion. Please conduct yourself in a manner that is respectful of the graduates and your fellow guests. Plan to attend the entire Convocation program. Each program will last approximately one hour and thirty minutes.
- As you enter, please proceed through the lobby to the stairs on your left, which lead to the upper level. There is an elevator to the right of the stairs for your use. Those persons with disabilities or the elderly and three of their guests may enter on the ground level through the arena doors to the left of the trophy cases off of the main lobby.
