The University of Delaware is located in Newark, Delaware, a small, friendly college town on the U.S. East Coast. Here are a few interesting facts about Newark:

- Population: Approximately 33,000
- 2 hours from New York
- 2 hours from Washington, D.C.
- 45 minutes from Philadelphia (the closest airport is the Philadelphia International Airport)
- "Classic American Main Street" in the city center, with many shops, cafes, and international foods
- Free University shuttle bus and cheap public transit
- Safe and friendly; traditional "college town"

What do Level Up Academics students do every day?

All students take 2 courses in the morning: a Leadership or STEM course and an academic writing skills course. These courses meet from 8:15 a.m. until approximately 12:35 p.m.

each day (Monday to Friday). Every afternoon, students have programming from approximately 1:30 to 5 p.m. that may include the following:

- American sports: baseball, basketball, football, volleyball
- Tours of some of UD's most popular colleges
- Hen zone game room: ping pong, billiards, foosball...
- Nature hikes
- Guitar club (learn to play!)
- **Picnics**
- **Pool parties**
- Movies

Students also participate in a fun-filled schedule of activities and excursions.

There are also many other local activities that students could do while in Delaware, such as:

Students must place into Level 4, 5, or 6 (i.e., intermediate-advanced levels) on the ELI English placement exam to enroll in Level Up Academics (This is approximately 5.0 or higher on the IELTS). If students place into Level 1, 2, or 3, they can participate in the Language Adventure USA program.
