Maya students need lower scores to the direct-admit to UD -> huge issue of students not being ready.

IBT minimum scores from 90 to 79 because of competition and trend from other places to reduce requirements

- IFS advisors and also UD ones
 - Housing with other freshmen
 - Grade replacement for courses
 - Non-Chinese the first year
 - Fall 2020: with Chinese
 - New, simpler ATQT for Fall '19? 4 hours for tests?!
 - AT 65 – min. 16 w/s
 - AT2 72 – min. 17
 - IULTS
 - AT1: 6.0 (60-78 IBT), subscores 5.5
 - AT2: 6, subscores of 6.0
 - No vote on IFS scores
- IFS Pilot for next fall
PASSED
- ARSC150-151 may consider curving grades
 - ¾ of the class won't move up
 - Need to make clear what students need to do to come here
 - Students retake the general assessment, not ATQT
 - More incentive to take IBT
 - If students get 5 or above, they take ATQT
 - Students that came in with IBT scores -> how they did and how they're doing -> Bridget and Kirsten
 - Students in US high schools are good socially, not academically
 - Expanded peer reviews: 2nd year, 4th, 6th, 13, not 9th
 - Enhanced review for 2 and 4
 - Course eval. Peoplesoft issues -> wall between UoD1 and UoD2
 - Acadeem courses not showing up (Sue)
