AT 1: 65 w/ min. score of **16** on writing/speaking

AT 2: 72 w/ min. score of **17** on writing/speaking

International 1st Year: 80 w/ minimum of “**18**” (said Scott Stevens)

TOEFL scores reduced

- Effective session: 1-19
- All AT students will still take placement testing for research purposes
- “ATQT doesn’t give us anything, but it’s good for people without TOEFL scores.”
 - Should we have no test, this “bad” test, or make a new one?
 - 80% of students couldn’t even pass
 - Scott isn’t ready to make a commitment in regards to this
 - Revision before vote
- Final essay writing rubric -> more editing before vote
- Students should get their work submitted to the anthology
 - It may disappear if there’s a lack of participation

- Writing rubric pilot postponed for now
 - In-house listening test in the works
