GIS Software at UD

- GIS software is available on <u>UDeploy</u>; software information is available on <u>UD-GIS site</u>
- Esri ArcGIS 10.5.1, ArcGIS Pro 2.0 are available for download
 - »Esri License server is updated to support both
- Esri released ArcGIS 10.6 and ArcGIS Pro 2.1
 - »Not on UDeply as UD is on the same version of software for the academic year
 - »ArcGIS Pro is a modern app, it should ask for updates. Esri advises to accept any updates and download/install of the newer version will take place if user is online
