# Winter 2013: Romania UAPP

January 11, 2013 - January 25, 2013 (dates are tentative)

### **Program Overview:**

This program has **changed their application deadline** to 09/14/2012.

This program encompasses a comparative study of public policy and public administration involving students from UD and Babes-Bolyai University (BBU) in Romania in a dual course in which students register at their home institution during spring semester 2013. Two orientation sessions during November 2012 will use interactive video technology. Research topics will be identified in consultation with students, and research teams will include students from both institutions. BBU and UD students will work cooperatively to develop survey instruments in advance of the trip, conduct interviews and collect secondary data in Romania, and write papers to be submitted at the conclusion of the course for partial satisfaction of a course grade. Meetings with well-informed individuals, and classes given by BBU faculty and Romanian public officials will complement information presented during orientation. Drafts of papers will be presented by students during a press conference on 1/24/13. Further discussion of papers will occur during interactive video class sessions following return to the United States. Faculty staff from BBU will support aspects of and all

Students will be housed in double room accommodation at the university which includes breakfast and a common area with three computers available for the group's use.

### **Courses:**

Students must enroll in all courses for credit and a grade; pass/fail and audit registration is not permitted. Please refer to the <u>University Catalog</u> to verify requirements and prerequisites

#### **UAPP 667: Comparative Public Administration and Public Policy (3 credits )**

This class provides a unique opportunity for students to enrich their understanding of academic areas of concentration by exploring ways in which differing governance systems and cultural backgrounds affect the way problems and issues are defined and policies are set out and acted upon.

### UNIV 370-066: Study Abroad (0 credits ) pass/fail

Students are asked to reflect upon changes in their knowledge, skills, and attitudes that occur due to their study abroad experience.

### **Program Costs:**
