For victims of sexual and gender-based violence

A Note about Privacy and Confidentiality:

Most University staff are required by federal law to provide victimization statistics regarding incidents of sexual assault, dating/domestic violence and stalking to the [Clery Compliance Officer](#) to be included on the annual Clery Report. All faculty and most staff are required to notify the [Title IX Coordinator](#) or Deputy Title IX Coordinators of incidents of sexual misconduct. (www.udel.edu/sexualmisconduct/policies/).

University offices that provide confidentiality (Center for Counseling & Student Development and certain professional counselors at Student Wellness & Health Promotion) will not share any information regarding an incident of sexual misconduct with anyone unless the victim grants permission to release the information. Only professional and pastoral counselors are recognized as providers who can offer this level of confidentiality.

S.O.S. and Student Health Services provide information to the Clery Compliance Officer for purposes of statistical reporting and timely warning notifications, and notify the Title IX Coordinator of incidents of sexual misconduct, but do not provide victims' names or identifying information unless given permission by the victim to do so.

Other University offices are required to submit names of those involved in an incident as well as other details to the Title IX Coordinator for possible investigation in the interest of the safety of the campus. All University offices work to ensure a victim's privacy, only sharing victim information as needed for referral to services or as required by federal law.
