Committee Actions:

At the June 13, 2017 meeting of the UDWC committee, the committee voted unanimously to accept the by-law changes that had not passed at the April 6 vote due to a low return of ballots. According to by-laws, changes in by-laws can also be passed by a 2/3 vote of the Executive Board.

■The committee approved an addition in Article II-Membership (in bold letters :

Membership is open to women employed by the University of Delaware (UD), current and retired; Wives, female domestic partners and widows of UD employees, current and retired; Female UD graduate students and the wives or female domestic partners of UD graduate students. *Membership is also open to any woman who supports the University of Delaware Women's Club's (UDWC) purpose and who wants to participate in UDWC activities.*

- Added to Article X- Woman of the Year the following addition
- *B- Criterion:* The Woman of the Year shall have made substantial volunteer contributions to UD or to the broader community. A- Eligibility was left the same wording; C- Deadline was part B, stays the same; D- Vote; was part C, stays the same.
- Article XI Amendments

 To correct the typo (affect should be **effect**).

UDWC Donates Scholarship Money

A Scholarship Donation of \$3000 was given to UD this July for the ACCESS program to help women students taking non-degree courses to start their entry into college. As non-credit students are not eligible for the usual scholarships, our donations really helps. Of the \$3000, \$1626 was directly from the generous donations of our members.

Target for next year—can we raise more than \$3000 for these students? A 3 credit course can cost up to \$1500 at UD. A donation line is on this year's membership form. We appreciate your contributions, whatever the amount.
