In its 4th season, the Loveville Produce Auction is a full service produce, ornamental plant, and fruit auction representing 100 growers. This auction is in a 14,000 square foot facility that operates from February through December. Sales begin at 9 am with a drive through auction followed by floor and small lot sales. Visitors during September will find a selection of cut flowers, most summer vegetable crops (tomatoes, watermelons, squash, lopes, peppers, sweet corn, etc...) and the start of late summer crops and transplants.

The Weavers produce cut flowers in roll-up side greenhouses and in the field on approximately 5 acres. They have a large variety of seasonal cut flowers year round, available by the stem or ready-made bouquets. The Weavers sell both wholesale and retail. They
