
1920 Letter of Aaron D. Gunn

The attached letter was sent to me by Dennis S. Gilman in the early 1990's. It was written by Aaron D. Gunn of Lancaster, NY to Spencer C. Gunn of Albany, NY in January 1920 to describe the original arrival of Moses Gunn in Shaftsbury/Bennington, Vermont. 
The author makes reference to his activities during the Civil War. He served 1862 - 1865 in the 140th Regiment of the Pennsylvania Infantry.








