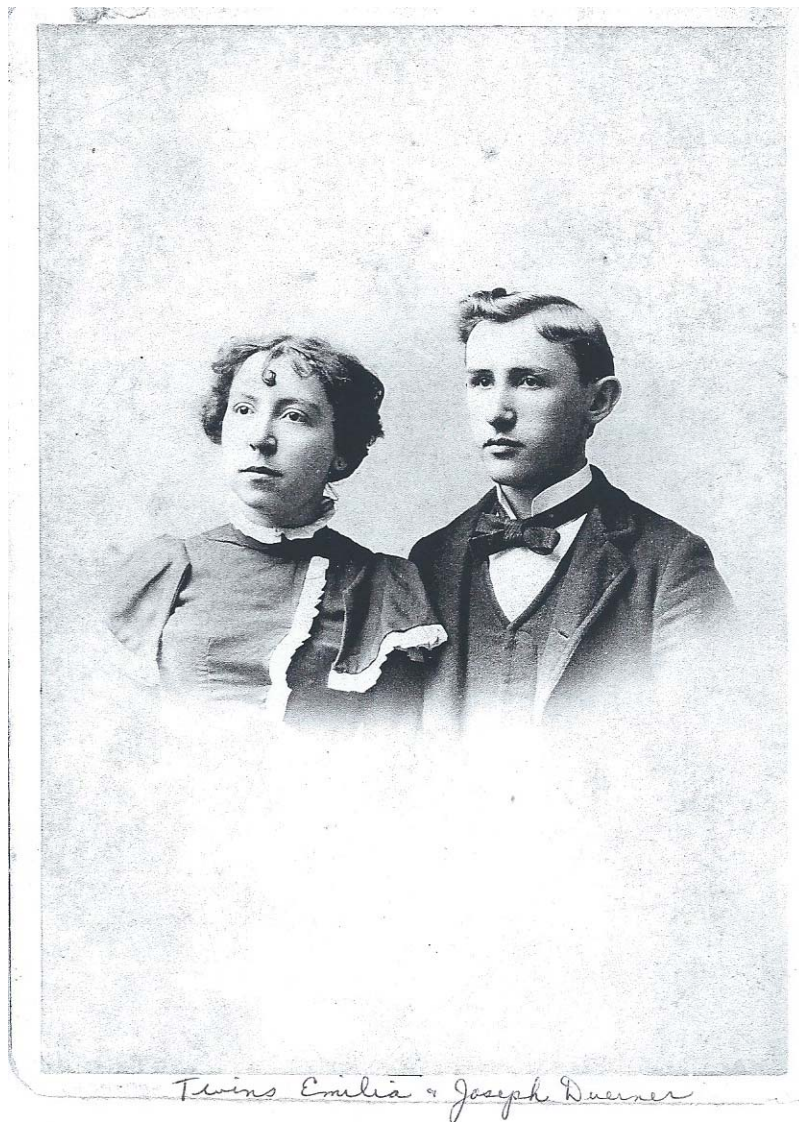
Photograph of Joseph Christoph Duerner with Three of his Sons



Comment by WVG: The three sons are identified as Joseph, John and Henry. But, the photo has to be from sometime after 1880, since John was born in 1881 and Henry in 1888. It seems quite possible that the photo was taken before 1888 and the sons are instead George, Joseph and John. The 1993 Family History notes that Joseph Christoph Duerner was a cooper by trade, and this photo looks very much like a location where he could have produced those wooden barrels.
