
Knauff Family Bible

The Knauff Family Bible belonged to Frederick Herman and America Harman Knauff, and it contained pages with a number of genealogical references. Photocopies of some of the pages from that Knauff Family Bible were included in the written genealogy of the Knauff Family in 1995. At that time, the Bible was in the possession of Carrie Dalrymple Knauff, the widow of Carl Edwin Knauff, and she provided the photocopies that were included in the genealogy. After the death of Carrie Knauff, the Family Bible changed hands and it is currently in the possession of Lyla Knauff Carr, the daughter of Lyle Knauff (the son of Carl and Carrie Knauff). The Family Bible has been restored, and Lyla Carr has provided photographs of many of the introductory pages of that Bible and of the photographs that were included in it.
