

Lineage from William Brewster to Hannah Perry Maxham

William Brewster was a passenger on the Mayflower, and it is easy to trace the path of his descendants to Hannah Perry. We know from *Lineage from Samuel Maxham to Edmund Maxham, Jr.* that Hannah Perry married Samuel Maxham and that one of their great-grandchildren was Silas Maxham who is buried in Chautauqua County, NY.

The lineage from William Brewster to Hannah Perry is taken completely from *Mayflower Births and Deaths (Volume 1)* by Susan E. Rosser, Genealogical Publishing Company, Baltimore, 1992.

Page 175 shows that William and Mary Brewster had six children, including a daughter named Patience Brewster.

Pages 214-215 indicate that Patience Brewster married Thomas Prence who was born about 1600 and he died March 29, 1783 in Plymouth. The couple had four children, including a daughter Rebecca Prence who was born before May 22, 1627.

Page 261 notes that Rebecca Prence married Edmund Freeman who was the son of Edmund Freeman, Sr. and he died before January 5, 1703 or 1704. The couple had two daughters, and one was named Rebecca Freeman who was born about 1650 and died after June 9, 1705.

Page 261 also shows that Rebecca Freeman married Ezra Perry, who was the son of Ezra Perry, Sr. and he was born February 11, 1652 in Sandwich, MA. The couple had nine children and one was a daughter named Hannah Perry who was born September 10, 1681.

<1> p.175, NEHGR 124:150 states that William Brewster was very possibly the son of William & Mary (Saythe). His date of birth has not been found, but it is believed to be c1566<NEHGR 18:18>.

<2> p.175, A great deal has been written about the identity of Mary and although many possibilities have shown up in print none have been verified. See Plymouth Colony, 1620-1691 by Eugene Stratton (1986), p.250 for discussion.

<3> p.177, Jonathan's will, dated 14 Mar. 1748 mentions eight children, viz: Peleg, Jonah, Hannah Barker, Mary (wf of Jeremiah Bingham), Jerusha (wf of Zebulon Rudd), Sarah Holmes, Elijah (b. 12 Mar. 1731) and Jonathan (b. 5 May 1737).

<6> p.181, Here we have an interesting story for its time. Christopher's wife Mary died 13 July 1676, ae 55. At the County Court of New London CT, 16 Sept. 1673, Elizabeth "Brawly" widow, was found guilty of committing fornication with Christopher Christophers, "which sin of hers is highly aggravated as being the second of y^e nature with the same party who is a married man. This Court having seriously considered the heinousness of the offence and also considering her present condition being neare the time of delivery, whereby shee is incaple of undergoing such punishment as the heinousness of the transgression may deserve, doe adjudge her to pay five pound fine and to weare a papour on her hatt on some publique day where on shall be written in capitall letters, Let the punishment of my whore done be a warning to others; or else to pay fiftene pound fyne..." Elizabeth chose to pay the fifteen pounds. <New London CT Court Records 3:63> Despite this fact, the Brewsters recorded the birth of John Christophers as the son of Christopher
